### **Awards:**

Ribbons awarded through 6th place. Classes will be split into Junior and Adult divisions if entries warrant.

**Prize Money will be given in any class with 3 or more riders as follows: 1st place \$15, 2nd place \$10, 3rd place \$5.**

High Point and Reserve High Point awards will be awarded to the horse/rider with the highest and second highest score in the regular Dressage division and in the Western Dressage division. Freestyle, Prix Caprilli and Rider Test test scores are not eligible.

Lisa Seger Insurance Medal will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Amateur in Training Level Test 3. Winner will be eligible for the Final to be held at the GDCTA Schooling Show in August.

## Participation Year End Awards:

Points will be awarded as follows:

10 points for each rider/horse combination per show

10 points for 3 rides per horse per show

15 points for show volunteers (runners, scribes, ring steward). Must be there 30 minutes before and after the show and stay and work the entire show. Volunteers can specify the horse/rider pair they want points to be applied to. In addition, volunteers will get 1 free dressage lesson for every 2 shows they work.

3 points for 1st place

2 points for 2nd place

1 point for 3rd place

The 3 horse/rider combinations with the highest total points at the end of the show series will win a Dover gift certificate worth \$100/\$50/\$25 for 1st/2nd/3rd and a free dressage lesson.

**Refunds:** Scratches prior to or on closing date: all fees except office fee will be refunded. Scratches after closing date: credit for future show will be given with valid vet or doctor's excuse. Credit is good for 1 year from date of show missed. Inclement weather is not a valid excuse for scratching.

**Substitutions:** Substitution of horse or rider before or after the closing date will require a new entry form with a new office fee. Class/stabling fees will be transferred to the new entry.

**Confirmation/Times:** Confirmation of entry will be by email. All email addresses must be clearly printed on entry form. Ride times will be emailed to the rider Wednesday before the show. If you do not have an email address or do not receive a confirmation and ride times via email, contact the Show Secretary. It is the responsibility of the competitor to notify management of any ride conflicts as soon as possible after times have been published.

**Stabling:** Day and overnight stabling available at \$50 per day/night. Stabling very limited, call for availability.

**Non-Compete Horse:** Non-competes are welcome as space permits. A complete entry is required along with coggins, signatures and office fee/non-competes horse fee paid.

**Special Classes:** If there is a class you would like to compete in and you don't see it here, just ask. We'll do our best to accommodate you.

## GDCTA Hold Harmless Clause

The undersigned competitor and all signors below hereby (1) agrees to release the management of this show, their officers, directors, employees, members, or agents, and the owners or managers of the grounds where this event is held, from any loss, damage, liability, or injury arising out of or resulting from this show or competitors participation therein; (2) agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc., the organizer, facility owner, and the management of this show from and against any and all claims for loss, damage, liability, or injury, however caused, resulting directly or indirectly from competitors entry or participation in this show or from acts or omissions of competitor or competitor's agents; and (3) acknowledges that activities with and around horses and horse shows involve inherent risks that are understood by the persons signing and are expressly assumed. In the event of injury to competitor or to competitor's animals permission is hereby granted to management for emergency medical treatment.

Every entry at a Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc. (GDCTA) recognized competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, handler, and the horse), for themselves, their principals, representatives, employees, and agents: (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the GDCTA and the local rules of the competition; (2) represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and of the competition, and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition, the GDCTA, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the GDCTA and the competition management to market, transfer, assign, or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event, sport, or the GDCTA, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to indemnify and hold harmless the GDCTA, the competition, and the officials, directors, employees, and agents from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, whether or not such claim, injury, or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of the GDCTA or competition. The construction and application of USEF Rules are governed by laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against USEF must be filed in New York State, see Article 1502.5.

## HOLD HARMLESS

### ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I [PRINT NAME HERE] \_\_\_\_\_ (hereafter, "Participant", which term includes Participant's parent or legally appointed Guardian, if a minor), freely and voluntarily seek to participate in any or all programs, events and/or activities sanctioned, produced, or sponsored by Danielle M Perry (DMP) that include educational and training programs, youth programs, clinics, and/or competitions at any time and at any location. These activities, programs, and events will hereafter be referred to as "the Activities," and DMP, together with its sponsors, managers, property owners, officials, organizers and affiliates and their respective directors, officers, members, employees, agents, volunteers, representatives, and designated officials will collectively be referred to as "Event Sponsor." In consideration of the Event Sponsor allowing Participant to participate in the Activities, now and in the future, Participant agrees as follows:

1. *Acknowledgment of Inherent Risks of Equine Activities/Assumption of Risks.* Participant acknowledges that there are numerous inherent risks of equine activities, whether preparing for, entering, attending, participating in, or leaving the Event. The inherent risks include those dangers and conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, *but not limited to:* (a) the propensity of an equine or other animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (b) the unpredictability of the equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movements and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (c) certain hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions; (d) collisions with other animals or objects; (e) the potential of a participant or other Participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant, Participant, or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within his or her ability; (f) the breakage or failure of tack or other equipment; and (g) the potential that an equine or animal may cause injury or harm to the rider or other persons or animals in the vicinity. *Participant is not relying on Event Sponsor to list within these documents all possible inherent risks or all risks of participating in any of the Activities at any location.*

2. *Waiver and Release of Liability.* With full knowledge and appreciation of these and other inherent risks associated with equine activities And the Activities, Participant freely and voluntarily assumes the risks of the equine activities involved in any aspect of them. In this connection, Participant also voluntarily agrees to waive any and all rights to sue and hereby releases the Event Sponsor from all liability, loss, claims, or actions for injury, death, expenses, or damage to person or property resulting from the inherent risks of the Event, or resulting from any action or inaction by the Event Sponsor. This waiver and release is effective even if the injury, death or damage to person or property is caused by, or contributed to by, actions or failure to act of the Event Sponsor and which actions or inactions constitute ordinary negligence or violation of any applicable law pertaining to equine activity liabilities. Neither Participant nor Participant's representatives shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or recover from the Event Sponsor or its sponsors, directors, officers, members, employees, agents, volunteers, representatives, designated officials, or others acting on their behalf for injury, loss, damage or death of the Participant, to the Participant's Horse, or to the Participant's personal property (regardless of ordinary negligence by the Event Sponsor or regardless of an alleged violation of an applicable equine activity liability law).

3. *Equine Liability Act.* Should the Activities take place in a state with an equine activity liability law, Participant acknowledges reading the applicable state warnings and/or provisions set forth below and on the next page (if any).
